Purposes of the Consultation Session

- ❖ Introduce the timetable for the Nomination of Representatives of Arts Interests for the Hong Kong Arts Development Council (HKADC)
- ❖ Introduce the arrangements of the Nomination Exercise
- ❖ Introduce the work of the HKADC by Representative of the Council
- ❖ Listen to the views of the arts sector on the arrangements of the exercise.

Relevant Sections under the Ordinance

- ❖ Hong Kong Arts Development Council Ordinance (Chapter 472) :
 - Section 3(3)
The Council shall consist of—
 - a) a Chairman, a Vice-chairman and not more than 22 other members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Chief Executive for a term not exceeding 3 years;
 - b) the Secretary for Home Affairs or his representative;
 - c) the Secretary for Education or his representative; and
 - d) the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services or his representative.

Relevant Sections under the Ordinance

❖ Hong Kong Arts Development Council Ordinance (Chapter 472) :

● Section 3(4)

The other members referred to in subsection (3)(a) may include up to 10 persons nominated by organizations or groups of organizations specified under subsection (5), and each such organization or group of organizations may nominate for this purpose not more than 1 person for each of the interests represented by that organization or group of organizations, and each such person shall, in the opinion of the Chief Executive, be experienced in the interest for which he has been nominated.

Relevant Sections under the Ordinance

❖ Hong Kong Arts Development Council Ordinance (Chapter 472) :

● Section 3(5)

The Chief Executive may by notice in the Gazette specify for the purposes of subsection (4) up to 10 organizations or groups of organizations each of which shall, in the opinion of the Chief Executive, be representative of one or more of the following interests—

* The Chief Executive will consider for appointment as members of the HKADC nominees returned from the nomination exercise for a term up to 3 years commencing 1 January 2011.

Arrangements of the Nomination Exercise

Phase I

(tentatively from end of March to mid-May)

Registration of Members of the Nominating Bodies

Arts Organizations/ Individual Arts Workers

Arts organizations/ individual arts workers specified in the gazette in 2007 as members of the nominating bodies of the respective arts interests will continue to be members of the nominating bodies for this term without the need for re-registration.

Arts organizations or individual arts workers participating in the nomination exercise for the first time must apply for registration as members of the nominating bodies of their respective arts interests in order that they can participate in the nomination exercise. Arts organizations/ individual arts workers specified in the gazette in 2007 that wish to update their particulars or change their arts interests must apply for registration again. (Arts organization should be established on or before 30 March 2009)

Return the completed application form and the supporting documents required.

Gazettal of members of the nominating bodies, tentatively scheduled for early June 2010

Arrangements of the Nomination Exercise

Phase II

(tentatively from early June to mid-July)

Individual members of the nominating bodies —

Individual members of the nominating bodies, that is, individual arts workers, upon registration and gazettal in Phase I, will automatically become voters and do not need to register.

Voter Registration

Individual/group or corporate members of the organizational members of the nominating bodies —

- (a) Individual member
 - Must apply through the organizations of which they are members. (To be eligible, an individual member must have joined the organization on or before 30 March 2009.)
 - Be aged 18 years or above
- (b) Group/ corporate members
 - For group/corporate members of the organizations concerned, only one representative of each group/corporate member is eligible to be registered as a voter.

In case the organizations to which (a) or (b) belong have been specified as members of nominating bodies of more than one arts interest, (a) or (b) should be registered under only one of those arts interests.

Arrangements of the Nomination Exercise

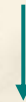
Phase III

(tentatively
from late July to
mid-August)

Nomination of Candidates

- The candidate shall –
 - (a) be aged 18 years or above; and
 - (b) be a registered voter of the arts interest for which he/she is standing for candidature; and
 - (c) be nominated by 5 proposers or 1% of the number of the registered voters from the same arts interest (whichever is the higher)

- The proposers shall –
 - (a) be registered voters of the respective arts interests; and
 - (b) shall make only one nomination in the nomination exercise



Announcement of the list of candidates

Arrangements of the Nomination Exercise

Phase IV

(tentatively
from the latter
half of August
to mid-
September)

Electioneering

- All electioneering activities shall commence only after the official announcement of the list of candidates.
- The HAB appointed nomination agent will assist the candidates in sending out their platforms to voters by mail, as well as arranging other electioneering activities.



Polling

- 3 days for polling (from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.) (The tentative polling dates will be in mid-September)
- A “cross-arts interests voting” system will be adopted (That is, if there are no uncontested seats, each registered voter will be voting for each of the 10 arts interests, casting a total of 10 votes).
- Counting of votes will be conducted after 9 p.m. on the third polling day. The results will be announced after the completion of vote-count.
